Per Rule 1-4 of the IHSAA By-Laws, sports that do not maintain at least 25% participation of the member schools will be reviewed annually for purposes of determining future tournament and recognition status. The number of member schools that participate in gymnastics is 76, of which sixteen field a partial team. A motion to continue IHSAA sponsorship of girls gymnastics was made by Paul Neidig; seconded by Mike Broughton; motion passed 19-0.

Assistant Commissioner Faulkens presented a list of track and field starters who have applied to work the 2013 tournament series.

Assistant Commissioner Gardner presented a list of baseball umpires who have applied to work the 2013 baseball tournament series.

#### **2012-13 SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT UMPIRES**

Assistant Commissioner Searcy presented a list of softball umpires who have applied to work the 2013 softball tournament series.

#### **SPORTSMANSHIP**

Assistant Commissioner Walter relayed information pertaining to unsportsmanlike conduct reports that have been received this spring. Unsportsmanlike conduct reports for sports have decreased from last year's figure. The new unsporting behavior report protocol was presented to the Executive Committee. This new process will be utilized by member schools and officials beginning in the 2013-14 school year.

#### FINANCIAL REPORTS ON SELECTED WINTER SPORTS

Assistant Commissioner Gardner reported on the attendance and finances for the 2012-13 Boys Basketball Tournament Series. Total paid attendance decreased from last year. Expenditures, however, decreased as well and the net result reflected in a 20% increase in the tournament net.

Assistant Commissioner Walter reported that attendance at all levels of the 2012-13 Girls Basketball Tournament increased, and expenditures decreased slightly as well. The net revenue reflected a 109% increase as a result.

Assistant Commissioner Walter provided the Executive Committee with the annual attendance and financial report for the 2012-13 Gymnastics Tournament Series. The net balance for the gymnastics tournament series showed a deficit of approximately \$4,000, which is an improvement over the previous year.

Commissioner Cox presented the budget analysis by sport through the Winter season.

### LITIGATION REPORT

Attorney Robert Baker updated the Executive Committee on the current status of pending litigation against the Association.

# **FOX SPORTS IHSAA TELEVISION AGREEMENT**

Assistant Commissioner Kaufman presented information associated with an agreement with Fox Sports Midwest. It will increase viewership opportunities at the state, regional, and national levels.

# REPORT OF NFHS SUMMIT AND LEGAL MEETING

Commissioner Cox, Assistant Commissioner Kaufman and Attorney Bob Baker attended the two day event.

The NFHS Network was discussed heavily at the Legal Summit. Each state maintains 1% ownership of the network. The states contribute nothing to the model. The NFHS contributes 1.5 million. They would like all states to participate so that they can sell national advertising. The NFHS are asking for at least 26 states to commit before they initiate plans for the Network. The events are listed in three Tiers – Tier 1 is encumbered by the state association; Tier 2 is everything that the state association owns such as the state tournament series; Tier 3 is all regular season events. The NFHS Board of Directors voted to proceed with plans to bring this to a vote to the membership for approval at the Summer Meeting.

Commissioner Cox reported on topics discussed during the recent NFHS Summit and Legal Meeting. The significant presentation on unified sports and there was a teleconference with the Office of Civil Rights, and the requirements that are already in place for member schools. Broadcast rights specifically associated with the Gannett case were discussed as well. Catastrophic injury claims and the length and breadth of coverage by state associations were discussed. Appeals hearing similarities and differences across state associations were addressed.

A variety of legal issues were shared amongst state associations executive directors and association attorneys. Counsel Bob Baker addressed the special accommodation issue relative to the Office of Civil Rights. The OCR does not require member schools to create new programs, but requires schools to incorporate students into programs already in place.

#### **PENALTIES ASSESSED**

The following penalties were assessed for various violations of the IHSAA By-Laws:

Andrean High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 20-1 (School's wrestling program ran a recruiting advertisement in a local newsletter – PROBATION).

- 1. The Andrean High School wrestling program is placed on probation for the 2013-14 season. This probation is a severe type of warning. It is official notice that serious violations have occurred, are a matter of record and future, similar incidents will not be tolerated.
- 2. Coach Mike Bauswell is severely reprimanded for allowing this unacceptable violation to occur.
- 3. Andrean High School shall report their course of correction within its athletic department in writing to the IHSAA within 30 days of receipt of this notice to insure these flagrant violations will not occur moving forward from this point.
- 4. A failure to comply may result in additional sanctions against the wrestling program and/or the school's athletic program.

Bremen High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 9-13 (Boys' basketball player was practicing in school facility on a Sunday).

- 1. The Bremen High School boys' basketball program is issued a warning.
- 2. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions of Bremen High School as appropriate measures in this matter.

Covenant Christian (Indpls.) High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (Two students participated in multiple swimming and diving meets without approved transfer reports on file).

- 1. The Covenant Christian boys' and girls' swimming and diving programs are issued warnings.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA by-laws, the meets in which the ineligible athletes participated in shall be re-scored after removing any scores posted by the ineligible athletes and the opposing schools notified of this violation.

Elkhart Memorial High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 20-4 (*Girls' basketball coach attended middle school contests at schools that are not direct feeder schools to his high school*).

- 1. The Elkhart Memorial High School girls' basketball program is issued a warning.
- 2. Coach Steve Scott is reprimanded for this violation.
- 3. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions of Elkhart Memorial High School as appropriate measures in this matter.

Floyd Central High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 3-10 (Several girls' tennis players participated in practices without an approved pre-participation physical and consent form on file).

- 1. The Floyd Central High School girls' tennis program is issued a warning.
- 2. This is a health and safety issue and it is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Pre-Participation Physical and Consent Form" be on file at the school for every student athlete prior to any practice let alone an interscholastic competition.
- 3. The IHSAA accepts the recommendations for correction submitted by Floyd Central High School.

Fort Wayne Concordia Lutheran High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-2.5 (Baseball program conducted an open facility opportunity in a non-school owned facility off campus).

- 1. The Fort Wayne Concordia Lutheran High School baseball program is issued a warning.
- 2. Open facility programs must be conducted in school facilities or at the specific competition venue when using a non-school facility.

Franklin County High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of violation of Rule 9-13 (Softball coach conducted practice on a Sunday with multiple players).

- 1. The Franklin County High School softball program is issued a warning.
- 2. Coach Ken Hammitt is reprimanded for this violation.
- 3. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions of Franklin County High School as appropriate measures in this matter.

Harrison (West Lafayette) - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of violation of Rule 9-13 (Baseball coach conducted practice on a Sunday with multiple players).

- 1. The Harrison High School baseball program is issued a warning.
- 2. Coaches Ryan Black, Andrew Morrical and Pat Lowrey are reprimanded for this violation.
- 3. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions of Harrison High School as appropriate measures in this matter.

Heritage Hills High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of violation of Rule 19-3 (Boys' golfer participated in multiple matches without an approved transfer report on file).

- 1. The Heritage Hills boys' golf program is issued a warning.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA by-laws, the matches in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be re-scored after removing any scores posted by the ineligible athlete and the opposing schools notified of this violation.

Marion High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (Softball player participated in two contests without an approved transfer report on file).

1. The Marion High School softball program is issued a warning.

- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA by-laws, the games in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Marion was victorious and the opposing schools notified of this violation.

Mishawaka Marian High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 9-13 (*Track coach conducted a practice on a Sunday with multiple student athletes*).

- 1. The Mishawaka Marian boys' and girls' track and field programs are issued a warning.
- 2. Coach Shannon Eversole is reprimanded for this violation.
- 3. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions of Mishawaka Marian High School as appropriate measures in this matter.

Salem High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (Boys' track athlete participated in a contest without an approved transfer report on file).

- 1. The Salem boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA by-laws, the meet in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be re-scored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete and the opposing schools notified of this violation.

Scottsburg High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (Foreign exchange student participated in multiple contests without an approved foreign exchange transfer report on file).

- 1. The Scottsburg High School boys' soccer and boys' swimming and diving programs are issued a warning.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Foreign Exchange Eligibility Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA by-laws, the soccer games in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited. Scottsburg High School shall notify all opposing schools of this violation.

South Bend Washington High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1 (Multiple boys' basketball players participated in contests while academically ineligible).

- 1. The South Bend Washington High School boys' basketball program is issued a warning.
- 2. The contests in which the ineligible athletes participated in shall be forfeited if South Bend Washington was victorious and the opposing schools shall be notified of these violations.

South Putnam High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1 (Girls' track athlete participate in multiple meets while academically ineligible).

- 1. The South Putnam High School girls' track and field program is issued a warning.
- 2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition until he meets the minimum standards for academic eligibility.
- 3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws all points scored by the ineligible athlete shall be removed from the team scores and those scores refigured. South Putnam High School shall notify all schools affected by this ruling.

South Ripley High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 50-1 (JV baseball player participated in a contest without completing 10 separate days of practice under the direct supervision of the coaching staff).

- 1. The South Ripley High School baseball program is issued a warning.
- 2. Coach Steve Franklin is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. This violation speaks to the health and safety of student athletes and it is absolutely imperative that such rules be enforced to the full extent.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA by-laws, the game in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if South Ripley was victorious and the opposing school notified of this violation.

Southwestern (Shelby) High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1 (Boys' track athlete participated in a meet while academically ineligible).

- 1. The Southwestern (Shelby) High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
- 2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition until he meets the minimum standards for academic eligibility.
- 3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws all points scored by the ineligible athlete shall be removed from the team scores and those scores refigured. Southwestern (Shelby) High School shall notify all schools affected by this ruling.

Speedway High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 9-13 (Softball players were using school facilities in the presence of the head coach on a Sunday).

- 1. The Speedway High School softball program is issued a warning.
- 2. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions of Speedway High School as appropriate measures in this matter.

Terre Haute South High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 8-3 (Boys' basketball coach publicly criticized game officials).

- 1. The Terre Haute South High School boys' basketball program is issued a warning.
- 2. Coach Scott Ridge is reprimanded for his public comments of licensed IHSAA officials.
- 3. The IHSAA accepts the recommendations for correction submitted by Terre Haute South High School.

Wawasee High School - Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-2.2a (*Ten boys' soccer players participated on the same non-school sponsored soccer team during the school year out of season*).

- 1. The Wawasee High School boys' soccer program is issued a warning.
- 2. Any player involved in the violation shall be suspended for one Wawasee High School soccer game during the 2013-14 season. These suspensions may be spread out over the first six regular season contests.
