Attorney Robert Baker updated the Executive Committee on the current status of pending litigation against the Association.

#### **PENALTIES ASSESSED**

East Central High School – (*Girls' soccer player participated in a non-school sponsored event without an approved waiver*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.2a.

- 1. The East Central High School girls' soccer program is issued a warning.
- 2. The IHSAA accepts the actions of East Central High School in the adjudication of this matter.

Evansville Mater Dei High School – (*Volleyball player played in a sectional contest without being placed on the entry list*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 3-8.

- 1. The Evansville Mater Dei High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
- 2. It is mandatory that all students intending on participating in IHSAA tournament series events be properly entered on the appropriate sectional entry list with all information complete.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9.4 a. of the IHSAA by-laws, the student shall be disqualified from eligible participation.
- 4. Evansville Mater Dei High School may enter the student onto the official entry list for \$200.00 after receiving approval from the IHSAA.

Fort Wayne Blshop Luers High School – (Football player participated in a varsity contest without an approved transfer report on file). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

- 1. The Fort Wayne Bishop Luers High School football program is issued a warning.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Athletic Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 a. of the IHSAA by-laws, the game in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Fort Wayne Bishop Luers was victorious and the opposing school notified of this violation.

Fremont High School – (Volleyball player participated in more than five sets against a single school in one day). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 111-4.

- 1. The Fremont High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
- 2. The six sets shall count toward the maximum number of sets allowed in a season for the student athlete involved in this rule violation.
- 3. In accordance with rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, the opposing school must be notified that this violation occurred and the match in which the maximum number of sets was exceeded must be forfeited if Fremont was victorious.

Hauser High School – (*Girls' soccer player participated in a match without an approved foreign exchange report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

- 1. The Hauser High School girls' soccer program is issued a warning.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Foreign Exchange Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 a. of the IHSAA by-laws, the match in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Hauser was victorious and the opposing school notified of this violation.

Herron High School – (*Volleyball player participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

- 1. The Herron High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 a. of the IHSAA by-laws, the games in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Herron was victorious and Herron shall notify all opposing schools of this violation.

Jennings County High School – (*Two boys' soccer coaches participated on a non-school league team with members of the high school team*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-2.2d.

- 1. The Jennings County High School boys' soccer program is issued a warning.
- 2. Coaches Ryan Beal and Brad Morris are reprimanded for committing this violation.
- 3. Coaches Beal and Morris shall be suspended from the first three Jennings County boys' soccer matches during the 2013-14 season.

Lawrence Central High School – (Volleyball player participated in multiple contests without an approved foreign exchange student eligibility report on file). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

- 1. The Lawrence Central High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
- 2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Foreign Exchange Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 a. of the IHSAA by-laws, the matches in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Lawrence Central was victorious and the opposing schools notified of this violation.

Lebanon High School – (*Football player participated in a camp during the authorized contest season*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.3.

- 1. The Lebanon High School football program is issued a warning.
- 2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended for one varsity contest.

North Posey High School - (*Boys' cross country runner participated in multiple meets while academically ineligible*)). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1.

- 1. The North Posey High School boys' cross country program is issued a warning.
- 2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition until he meets the minimum standards for academic eligibility.
- In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws all points scored by the ineligible athlete shall be removed from the team scores and those scores refigured. North Posey High School shall notify all schools affected by this ruling.

Twin Lakes High School – (Football player participated in multiple junior varsity contests without an approved transfer report on file). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

- 1. The Twin Lakes High School football program is issued a warning.
- It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in any interscholastic event.
- 3. As per Rule 3-9 a. of the IHSAA by-laws, the games in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Twin Lakes was victorious and the opposing schools notified of this violation.
