## Minutes

## Emergency By-Law Adoptions

Commissioner Bobby Cox and Attorney Bob Baker spoke to the following potential by-law adoptions for consideration:

1. Proposed amendment to IHSAA Rule 1-2, Recognized Sports, to recognize the adoption of Unified Flag Football

### Rule 1-2 Recognized Sports

The following sports are recognized and regulated: Boys – baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, soccer, swimming, tennis, track and field, wrestling; Girls – basketball, cross country, golf, gymnastics, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, track and field, volleyball; Unified Sports® - track and field, flag football.

*A motion for approval was made by Steve Cox; seconded by Mike Broughton; motion approved 18-0.*

2. Proposed amendment to IHSAA Rule 7-4, Continuing Education for Athletic Director, to update the course requirements for continuing education of athletic directors:

### Rule 7-4 Continuing Education for Athletic Directors

Every athletic director, or activities director with oversight for athletics, must successfully complete an organization and administration class prior to being employed for a second year. Note: This rule does not apply to those individuals hired prior to the 2008-09 school year.

- a. The organization and administration component requires the successful completion of:
  - (1.) ~~IHSAA~~AAA New Athletic Administrators' class offered each July, and
  - (2.) LTC 5042 offered by NIAAA at state and national conferences, as well as online at [www.ihsaa.org](http://www.ihsaa.org).
- b. Member Schools shall maintain a record of training completed by athletic administrators. This record shall be furnished to the Association on request of the Commissioner or his designee. Failure to complete the required education within the appropriate time frame shall result in a fifty-dollar (\$50.00) fine for the first year and a hundred-dollar (\$100.00) fine for each additional year of non-compliance.

3. Proposed amendment to Rule 8-4, the Contest Ejection Rule, to include an ejected "Fan" (who will be defined in the definitions) as a person who shall be suspended from the next One (1) or Two (2) home games:

**Rule 8-4 Contest Ejection**

a. Any contestant, ~~or~~ coach, Contest Administrator, ~~or~~ School Administrator or Fan, who is ejected from a Contest for an unsportsmanlike act the first time during a sports season shall be suspended from the next interschool Contest (Home Contest for a Fan) at that level of competition and all other interschool Contests (Home Contests for a Fan) at any level in the interim, unless an IHSAA sport-specific rule or policy provides a different protocol or penalty for ejections.

\* \* \* \*

c. Any contestant, coach, Contest Administrator, ~~or~~ School Administrator or Fan, who is ejected from a Contest for an unsportsmanlike act a second time during a sport season shall be suspended for the next two (2) Contests (Home Contests for a Fan) at that level of competition and all other Contests (Home Contests for a Fan) at any level in the interim, unless an IHSAA sport-specific rule or policy provides a different protocol or penalty for a second ejection.

*A motion for approval was made by Steve Cox; seconded by Mike Broughton; motion approved 18-0.*

- 4. Proposed amendment to Rule 15-2.3(d) to increase the number of soccer students from a member school who may attend a Camp or Clinic together, during the School Year, Out-of-Season:

**Rule 15-2.3 Camps and Clinics**

Students may attend Camps and Clinics provided the following standards are met.

\* \* \* \*

d. No more than Three (3) students in basketball and volleyball, ~~F~~five (5) students in baseball and softball, ~~or~~ Six (6) students in football ~~and or~~ Seven (7) in soccer who have participated in a Contest the previous year as a member of One (1) of their School teams in that sport may participate on the same team or in the same work station or drill at the same time. All work stations or drills must be held independent of each other and may not be integrated to simulate a game.

- 5. Proposed new amendment to Rule 200-9.0 to recognize Unified Flag Football:

**200-9.0 Recognized Unified Sports<sup>®</sup>.**

The following sport(s) are recognized and regulated as Unified Sports<sup>®</sup>: track and field (Unified Sport) and flag football (Unified Sport).

- 6. Proposed new section to Rule 201 to establish the Practice and Contest Seasons for Unified Flag Football:

**Rule 201 – Unified Sports<sup>®</sup> Seasons**

- Proposed new to Rule 203 to establish the rules for Unified Flag Football:

**RULE 203 – FLAG FOOTBALL.**

See rule 9, Contests, which applies to all sports.

**203-1 Playing Rules**

The Special Olympics Indiana Unified Flag Football rules shall govern except as so modified by the Committee.

**203-2 Maximum Season Contests**

The maximum number of Season Contests in Unified Flag Football in which any team may participate, and the maximum number of halves in which a student may participate, excluding the IHSAA Tournament Series, shall be Ten (10) team Contests and Twenty (20) student halves.

- A student may participate in no more than Three (3) halves in One (1) session. When multiple Contests are played on One (1) admission ticket without clearing the stands i.e. junior-varsity Contest followed by a Varsity Contest, it is considered One (1) session.
- Student may not change levels of play if Contests are being played simultaneously. Students may only change levels of play at the completion of both Contests.
- See rule 201 for Practice and Contest Seasons.

**203-3 Controlled Scrimmage**

A School may schedule One (1) Unified Flag Football Controlled Scrimmage with another IHSAA member School. A Unified Flag Football Controlled Scrimmage may not be held earlier than the day following the fifth (5th) day of Practice or later than the second (2nd) calendar day prior to the first (1st) scheduled Contest. A Unified Flag Football Controlled Scrimmage does not count as a Practice or as an interschool Contest. Only students who have full athletic eligibility may participate in a Unified Flag Football Controlled Scrimmage.

### **Penalties Assessed**

Andean HS – Rule 3-9.4 (*Softball player was omitted from the sectional entry list and participated in the tournament series*)

1. The Andean High School softball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Athletic Director Kelly Fitzgerald and Head Softball Coach Glen Eisfelder are reprimanded for allowing this error to occur. It is imperative that the athletic director along with the head coach insure that the entry list for each team entered into an IHSAA tournament series is accurate in every detail.

Attica HS – Rule 51-4 (*Baseball pitcher exceeded the maximum number of pitches allowed*)

1. The Attica High School baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Kyle Neal is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. The revisions of Rule 51-4 have been written to promote the health and safety of student athletes in the sport of baseball along with creating a level field of competition between schools.
3. As per Rule 3-9.5a of the IHSAA by-laws, the game in which the violation occurred shall be forfeited. Attica High School shall notify their opponent of this violation.

Boone Grove HS – Rule 19-3 (*Softball player participated in a contest without an approved foreign exchange student eligibility report on file*)

1. The Boone Grove softball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed foreign exchange student eligibility report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contest where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Boone Grove was victorious. The opposing school shall be notified of this violation.

Christian Academy of Indiana – Rule 19-3 (*Baseball and track and field athlete participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Christian Academy of Indiana boys' track and field program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The Christian Academy of Indiana baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
3. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.

4. The track and field meets the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete if a team score was calculated. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.
5. The baseball games the ineligible student participated in shall be forfeited. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Christian Academy of Indiana – Rule 19-3 (*Girls' tennis player participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Christian Academy of Indiana girls' tennis program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The tennis matches the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete if a team score was calculated. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Cloverdale HS – Rule 51-4 (*Two baseball players pitched in a game without the requisite number of days of rest*)

1. The Cloverdale High School baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Kent Bass is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. The revisions of Rule 51-4 have been written to promote the health and safety of student athletes in the sport of baseball along with creating a level field of competition between schools.
3. As per Rule 3-9.5a of the IHSAA by-laws, the game in which the violation occurred shall be forfeited. Cloverdale High School shall notify their opponent of this violation.

Concord HS – Rule 19-3 (*Girls' track and field athlete participated in multiple meets without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Concord High School girls' track and field program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The meets the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete if a team score was calculated. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Covenant Christian (DeMotte) HS – Rule 9-6a (*Junior varsity baseball coach allowed a student from another school to play for his team in an interschool contest*)

1. The Covenant Christian High School baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Coach Jeff Eenigenburg is reprimanded for causing this violation to occur. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable excuse for causing a violation to be committed.

Culver Academies – Rules 9-13, 15-1.1, 15-2.1 (*Wrestling program committed several violations during the authorized contest season and during the school year out of season*)

1. The Culver Academies wrestling program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Matt Behling is reprimanded for allowing these violations to occur. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable excuse for a rules violation.

2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be declared ineligible immediately. The student may gain academic eligibility at the next certification date of the school.
3. The matches that the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to reflect the removal of any matches won by the ineligible student. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Goshen HS – Rule 15-1.2a (*Baseball player participated in a non-school baseball game during the authorized contest season*)

1. The Goshen High School baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The suspension of Skylar Reyes by Goshen High School on May 2, 2018 is a sufficient and acceptable penalty in this matter

Hammond HS – Rule 18-1 (*Boys' track and field athlete participated in an interscholastic meet while academically ineligible*)

1. The Hammond High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be declared ineligible immediately. The student may gain academic eligibility at the next certification date of the school.
3. The meet that the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to reflect the removal of any points scored by the ineligible student. The opposing school shall be notified of this violation.

Indianapolis Scecina Memorial HS – Rule 51-4 (*Baseball pitcher exceeded the number of pitches allowable in a day*)

1. The Scecina Memorial High School baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Dave Gandolph is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. The provisions of Rule 51-4 have been written to promote the health and safety of student athletes in the sport of baseball along with creating a level field of competition between schools. It is incomprehensible that a head coach possessing multiple years of experience could make such an error.
3. As per Rule 3-9.4a1 of the IHSAA by-laws, student athlete Mac Ayres is disqualified from the IHSAA semi state contest vs. Southridge on Saturday, June 9, 2018. Should Scecina Memorial High School advance to the state finals, Mr. Ayres will become eligible to participate.

Indianapolis Shortridge HS – Rule 8-4a (*Baseball player failed to serve suspension for contest ejection*)

1. The Indianapolis Shortridge High School baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student completes the mandatory suspension.
3. Any contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Indianapolis Shortridge was victorious. The opposing school(s) shall be notified of this violation.

Kankakee Valley HS – Rule 9-6a (*Junior varsity baseball coach allowed a student to represent another school in an interschool contest*)

1. The Kankakee Valley High School baseball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Junior Varsity Coach Jordan VanWiennen is reprimanded for causing this violation to occur. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable excuse for causing a violation to be committed.
3. The baseball game between Kankakee Valley and Covenant Christian is hereby declared a double forfeit.

LaPorte HS – Rule 15-2.5 (*Alumni participated with boys' basketball players in an open facility session*)

1. The LaPorte boys' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Kyle Bengé is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable rationale for violating IHSAA by-laws.

Lowell HS – Rule 18-1 (*Boys' golfer participated in multiple matches while academically ineligible*)

1. The Lowell High School boys' golf program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be declared ineligible immediately. The student may gain academic eligibility at the next certification date of the school.
3. The meets that the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to reflect the removal of any scores recorded by the ineligible student. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Madison Consolidated HS – Rule 19-3 (*Boys' track and field athlete participated in multiple meets without an approved foreign exchange student eligibility request on file*)

1. The Madison Consolidated High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed foreign exchange student eligibility report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The meets the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete if a team score was calculated. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Muncie Burriss HS – Rule 15-1.1d (*Girls' tennis player hit with students previously eliminated during tournament series while still participating in series*)

1. The Muncie Burriss High School girls' tennis program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended for the first interscholastic girls tennis match on the Muncie Burriss girls tennis schedule for the 2018-19 school year.

New Castle HS – Rule 15-2.2d (*Volleyball coach instructed students in a non-school sponsored club*)

1. The New Castle High School volleyball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Sarah Roush is reprimanded for this violation. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable excuse for a rules violation.

New Castle HS – Rule 18-1 (*Boys' track and field athlete participated in multiple meets while academically ineligible*)

1. The North Knox High School volleyball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Coach Mandy Haag is reprimanded for this violation. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable excuse for a rules violation.

North Montgomery HS – Rule 9-14c (*Softball player failed to accomplish six practices after an extended absence*)

1. The North Montgomery High School softball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Coach Jessie June is strongly reprimanded for causing this violation to occur. Rule 9-14 provides safeguards for student athletes returning to competition after an absence and shall be strictly adhered to.

Wabash HS – Rule 19-3 (*Boys' track and field athlete participated in a meet without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Wabash High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The meet the ineligible student participated in shall be rescored to remove any points earned by the ineligible athlete if a team score was calculated. The opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.
